Dear Parent or Guardian,

Do you know that Tick Borne Diseases are bacterial infections caused by a tick bite? Most cases of Tick Borne Diseases can be treated successfully with a few weeks of antibiotics. If left untreated, infection can spread to joints, the heart, and the nervous system.

Our campaign theme this year is, "<u>Safe Steps</u>". It is important to know how to protect yourself from ticks and how to avoid exposure to ticks and possibly Tick Borne Diseases. Preventing tick bites and removing ticks that do bite are key to preventing Tick Borne Diseases.

This is why we are encouraging your child to participate in this year's "<u>Safe Steps</u>" art competition. Please join us in this opportunity to help educate your child and their peers about where ticks are found and how to prevent encountering ticks in their habitat.

This art contest is open to children in grades K-6, broken into four groups: grades K, 1-2, 3-4, 5-6. One winner from each group will be chosen.

Safe Steps Art Competition Guidelines:

Competition Rules:

- Entries will be judged in one of the four groups: grade K, grades 1-2, grades 3-4, and grades 5-6.
- Only <u>one</u> entry allowed per child.
- Each submission must illustrate "Where do ticks live" or "How to protect yourself from Tick Bites."

Submission guidelines:

- Posters should be on drawing or heavy construction paper. No larger than 12" x 18". Do not laminate or mount.
- Submissions must be drawn or handwritten.
- To be considered, submissions must be accompanied by a completed contest form (below). The contest form should be firmly attached to the back of the poster.

Judging Criteria:

- Be an original work of the contestant
- Include at least one location where ticks can be found or at least one tick bite prevention technique
- Demonstrate creativity
- Be neat in its appearance
- Most importantly, have fun and be creative!
