

## 2024 General Primary Election UMOVA Notice

This is an official notice of the Pike County General Primary Election to be conducted on April 23, 2024. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at [www.vote.pa.gov](http://www.vote.pa.gov) or [www.fvap.gov](http://www.fvap.gov).

You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to 570-296-6055, by email to [nmanzoni@pikepa.org](mailto:nmanzoni@pikepa.org) or mail to:

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are entitled to vote using the Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for all state and local offices, and ballot questions. Please refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for state or local offices, write the names of candidates in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the Office/Ballot Initiative heading, enter the office the candidate is running for. Under the Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write “yes” or “no”.

Enrolled members of the Democratic Party may only vote for Democratic Candidates. A vote for a candidate of another party will be counted as a write-in vote.

Enrolled members of the Republican Party may only vote for Republican Candidates. A vote for a candidate of another party will be counted as a write-in vote.

Enrolled members of all other non-affiliated parties may only vote on the ballot questions. Votes for candidates will not be counted.
