WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Acts of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in such case made and provided, regulation the holding of General Primary Elections, it is made the duty of the County Commissioners in every county within this commonwealth to publish written notice designating the offices for which candidates are to be nominated for the General Primary Election

NOW, THEREFORE, we the County Board of Elections of the County of Pike do make known by this proclamation to the registered voters of said County that on

TUESDAY, APRIL 24, 2012

the General Primary Election will be held between the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 pm. in all 18 election precincts within the County of Pike, at which time and place, the qualified electors of the Republican and Democratic parties will assemble and vote by ballot for the nomination of candidates for the following offices:

- 1 Representative in Congress 10th District
- 1 Representative in the General Assembly 139th District

- 3 Alternate Delegates to the Republican National Convention
- 6 Delegates to the Democratic National Convention (3 males, 3 females)
- 1 Republican County Committeeperson At Large
