Fast Facts

Pike County Transportation has four programs to help you get where you need to go.

Shared Ride Program: Helps older adults age 65+ access medical, financial, and social services. We provide service to all three senior centers, grocery stores, banks, and post offices on scheduled days.



Moving Forward: Helps people age 18 to 64 with physical, mental, or major life activity disabilities access the same services as the Shared Ride Program.



Medical Assistance Transit: Helps medical assistance recipients of all ages access medical and pharmacy needs only.



Pike County Connect: Pike County residents who do not fit into any of the categories above can get a ride through this program.

Need an Escort?

An escort is a person that accompanies you to your appointments. You may be required to have an escort ride with you for your safety and wellbeing because of certain physical, medical, or mental conditions. All escorts must be a parent, legal guardian, foster parent, or 25 years of age or older who is registered and documented with the Pike County Transportation Office. If you have an escort, they must stay with you at all times.

Transportation Guidelines

Registration: The Pike County Transportation Office must have a completed registration form for all consumers before service is provided. An authorized signature is required to verify disabilities.

Pickup: You must be ready 2 hours before your scheduled appointment time and be at your designated pickup location.

Service: There is no service on Sundays or holidays. Listen to 96.7 WTSX or call (570) 296-1959 for weather cancellations. You will not be notified.

Snacks and Medication: You may bring along a bottle of water, snack, and medications.



Shopping: You will have 1 to 1.5 hours to shop. You must shop within the amount of time the driver tells you. You can get up to five (5) bags of groceries (food only). You cannot get 40-pound bags of animal feed, topsoil, or multiple cases of water.

Car Seats/Booster Seats: Car Seats and Booster Seats are needed when applicable and will not be provided by Pike County.

Cell Phones: Please limit cell phone use while riding in our vehicles in consideration of the driver and other passengers.

Drivers: Drivers cannot make unscheduled stops, carry your groceries, enter your residence, carry your wheelchair up and down steps, or accept gratuities.

Scheduling: Call at least 48 hours in advance (not including weekends/holidays) to schedule an appointment or extra stop. Advance notice of more than 24 hours is appreciated for weekends and holidays.

Cancellations: Call at least 24 hours in advance to cancel your appointment.

Suspension of Service: We reserve the right to suspend service to people who do not comply with our policies and procedures to ensure a safe, enjoyable, and on-time ride for everyone.
